Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend Catholics throughout the world celebrate the solemnity of Corpus Christi. As Catholics we believe that in the Mass when Jesus' words of consecration are prayed over the bread and wine, that the bread and the wine are transformed into the very body and blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. This is the same person who was crucified, died and was buried for our sakes. We believe that Jesus literally meant what he said in the Gospel: "unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink."

As you know each weekday from 2pm to 6pm the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in our chapel. Many parishioners come to pray each day, which is a powerful sign of their love for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. As your pastor I encourage you to make short visits to the Blessed Sacrament during the week. Let us recall the words of Christ, "Come to me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will refresh you."
