The Women's Guild is very active in our Parish - we are behind the scenes in so many things! For example, we make crosses for the First Communicants and Confirmandi each year, as well as baptismal bibs for those babies baptized in our Parish. We also support the Rose of Sharon with poinsettia sales at Christmas. Our main fundraising event, however, is our annual Christmas Bazaar, held at the beginning of November, which usually raises about \$5,000! It also

promotes a wonderful community spirit, with the whole Parish coming together to help.

The money raised from our bazaars goes directly back into the Church - funds in previous years were used to purchase the statue of St. Elizabeth Seton, ciboriums for distributing Communion, the Church sign and the keyboard in the library, used extensively by the various choirs in the Parish. In 2006 we helped towards the cost of the Tabernacle, as well as the purchase of cassocks, surplices, stoles for our Deacons, Lectionary cover, Funeral Pall and more. We also support the St. Vincent de Paul Society, and just this past December donated \$200.
